WEATHER CONDITIONS

The 2023 vintage is in line with the trend towards global warming, with an early vine cycle followed by an episode of spring frost which had an impact on our Merlot vines.

The summer season was no easy ride. It was marked by a series of stormy spells which were favourable to the development of mildew. However, our good plant health management and the commitment of our teams enabled us to preserve the quality of the harvest.

The heatwave that followed in August resulted in a significant loss of berry weight on the gravelly, sandy soils, but helped the grapes to ripen beautifully.

THE HARVEST

An early harvest began on 13 September at Château Beaumont. The warm weather enabled us to spread the harvest over 2 weeks so that we could pick our three grape varieties in the best possible conditions. The berries harvested are concentrated.
